Leopold was founded in 1923 and evolved into a children's- and young-adult publishing house in the 1950's. From baby books to books for young adults, from poetry to exceptional non-fiction, Leopold publishes for all ages. Leopold has a lot of collaborations with museums, different organizations and the government.

Leopold hosts a lot of famous Dutch authors, for example the classic works of Tonke Dragt (*The Letter for the King, The Secrets of the Wild Wood*). Several popular brands are also published by Leopold, like Frog (Max Velthuijs) and Alfie the Werewolf (Paul van Loon). The beautiful Leopold picture books by renowned illustrators like Annemarie van Haeringen, Wouter van Reek, Thé Tjong-Khing and Kaatje Vermeire are taking a flight due to the fantastic teamwork with museums.

Not only classic authors and popular brands are a big part of Leopold. A younger generation of authors and illustrators is building a vast oeuvre. Books like *Zeb*. (Gideon Samson & Joren Joshua) and *Escape Room 2.0* (Maren Stoffels) shake up the world of children's literature.

From the books about Mouse and Bear by Pauline Baartmans and other cozy stories to read aloud, to the intriguing books about space and space travel by astronaut André Kuipers, Witte Leeuw has a book for everybody. Learn more about nature and farm life with the cheerful characters Fien & Teun and enjoy the adventures of pony Spot in the Spot book series! And if you're looking to go on your own adventure, Marcel Groenewegen's *Gamebook Shadow Crow* is a great pick for you.

Ploegsma Publishers

For well over a hundred years Ploegsma has been part of the Dutch publishing scene. The publishing house was founded in 1905 by Johannes Ploegsma and has been specializing in children's books since the 1960's: adventurous and humorous fiction and non-fiction books for children of all ages. These include many classic titles, such as the books by Astrid Lindgren (*Pippi Longstocking*) and Arnold Lobel (*Frog and Toad*), as well as books by contemporary and very popular authors like Mirjam Oldenhave (*Mister Twister*), Marjon Hoffman (*Rosie's Rules*), Reggie Naus (*The Pirates Down the Street*), Vivian den Hollander, Janny van der Molen, Yorick Goldewijk, Octavie Wolters and Caja Cazemier. Many of these authors have been translated.

Even though a lot has changed in the last hundred years, Ploegsma's love for beautiful books has not!



100 years Max Velthuijs!

Max Velthuijs (1923-2005) is one of the most well-known Dutch illustrators. Around 1.5 million of his books found their way to living rooms, schools and libraries all over the world and his work was published in more than 35 countries. Max was awarded the Hans Christian Andersen Award in 2004 and many Silver and Golden Paintbrushes and Pencils. Frog was his alter ego. A sympathetic and naïve optimist. "Isn't life wonderful!" was his motto. Max could work a year on one book, working on and improving illustrations time after time. Most of all, he wanted the illustrations to seem 'effortlessly made'.

Lizette de Koning is a master of the light verse, short and witty texts parents and children want to read again and again. This book is no exception and will be cherished in nurseries everywhere.







But what if Ko still wants to return home? Together with his friends he goes all out not to miss the last chance to fly back. But will that even be possible...?







My Very Own Comic Book
