Leopold was founded in 1923 and evolved into a children's- and young-adult publishing house in the 1950's. From baby books to books for young adults, from poetry to exceptional non-fiction, Leopold publishes for all ages. Leopold has a lot of collaborations with museums, different organizations and the government.

Leopold hosts a lot of famous Dutch authors, for example the classic works of Tonke Dragt (*The Letter for the King, The Secrets of the Wild Wood*). Several popular brands are also published by Leopold, like Frog (Max Velthuijs) and Alfie the Werewolf (Paul van Loon). The beautiful Leopold picture books by renowned illustrators like Annemarie van Haeringen, Wouter van Reek and Kaatje Vermeire are taking a flight due to the fantastic teamwork with museums.

Not only classic authors and popular brands are a big part of Leopold. A younger generation of authors and illustrators is building a vast oeuvre. Books like *Zeb*. (Gideon Samson & Joren Joshua) and *Fright Night* (Maren Stoffels) shake up the world of children's literature.

For well over a hundred years Ploegsma has been part of the Dutch publishing scene. The publishing house was founded in 1905 by Johannes Ploegsma and has been specialising in children's books since the 1960's: adventurous and humorous fiction and non-fiction books for children of all ages. These include many classic titles, such as the books by Astrid Lindgren (*Pippi Longstocking*) and Arnold Lobel (*Frog and Toad*), as well as books by contemporary and very popular authors like Mirjam Oldenhave (*Mister Twister*), Marjon Hoffman (*Rosie's Rules*), Yvon Jaspers (*Tess and Tommy*), Reggie Naus (*The Pirates Down the Street*), Vivian den Hollander, Janny van der Molen and Caja Cazemier. Many of these authors have been translated.

Even though a lot has changed in the last hundred years, Ploegsma's love for beautiful books has not!





100 years Max Velthuijs!

Max Velthuijs (1923-2005) is one of the most wellknown Dutch illustrators. Around 1,5 million of his books found their way to living rooms, schools and libraries all over the world and his work was published in more than 35 countries. Max was awarded the Hans Christian Andersen Award in 2004 and many Silver and Golden Paintbrushes and Pencils. Frog was his alter ego. A sympathetic and naïve optimist. "Isn't life wonderful!" was his motto. Max could work a year on one book, working on and improving illustrations time after time. Most of all, he wanted the illustrations to seem 'effortlessly made'.


One of the most important things to teach a child is how to say yes and no. To be clear about what they do want and what they don't want, and to realize that it's important that other people respect that. So when your auntie wants to give you a kiss while you'd rather she didn't, it's okay to say so. And it's wrong for parents to push you into giving in, because that just teaches you that your boundaries are not important and you have no say in what happens to your body.

At the same time, it's equally important to teach kids to express what they do like and want. That forms the basis for happy relationships as adults.

The aim of the book is to encourage parents and children to talk about expressing boundaries, wishes and consent together.

Philippine van der Goes is a coach, author and mother of a young son. Dr. Karin Middelburg is a gynaecologist and mother of three. Together they decided to write the book they themselves missed as parents to young kids: honest books about sexual education, with a sense of humour and with room for diversity.
